3. Why were the Indian soldiers unhappy with the new rifles? (5)

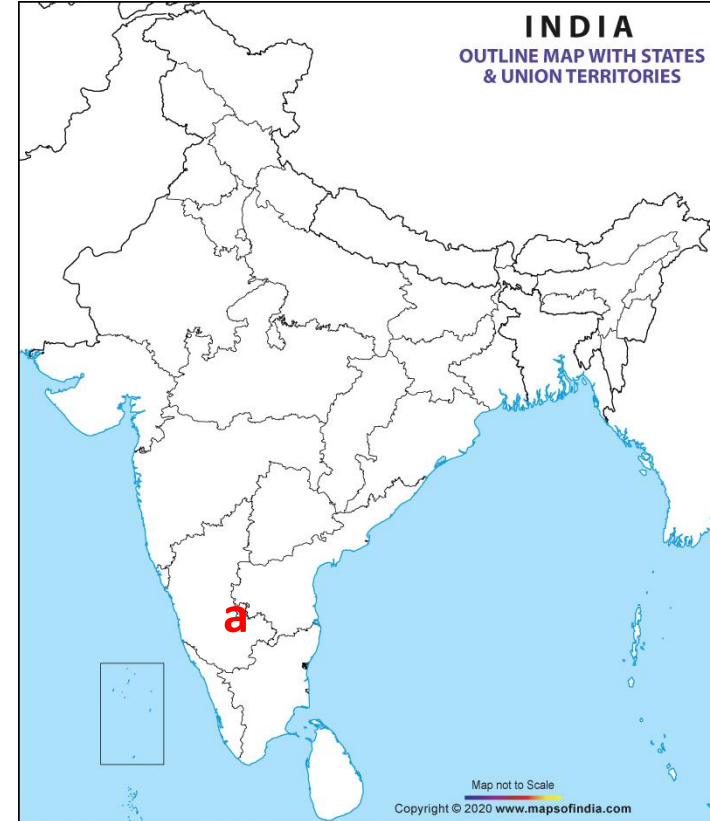
