

- Ensure law and order is maintained in the country



b. Maximum strength - 552 530 members from states 20 members from Union Territories 2 members from Anglo-Indian Community (nominated by president)	b. Maximum - 250 seats 238 seats selected by States and Union Territories and 12 members nominated by President
c. Presided by the speaker	c. Presided by the chairman (Vice President)
d. Members are elected for 5 years	d. Members are elected for 6 years
e. It is a temporary house.	e. Every two years, one-third of the members retire. So, in a way it is a permanent house.


