
- This is the northern-most range of the Himalayas.

The slopes are covered with thick forests which are home to a variety of wild animals.




The area at the foothills of Shivalik range is called the Terai region. It receives heavy rainfall and the land is fertile.



- ❑ Deforestation in the Shiwalik and the Terai region for wood and farmland has destroyed many of the forests.
- ❑ The government has made several protected forest areas such as Corbett National Park and the Kaziranga National Park.
- ❑ To stop deforestation and protect animals
- ❑ planting of trees is also being taken up.

Ans. The word Himalaya has been taken from the Sanskrit word - Himalaya- Hima (snow)+ Alaya (house).

As a large part of Himalayan Range is covered with snow throughout the year, it is named as Himalaya.
