INTRODUCTION:

The Globe

The globe is a small model of the Earth. It is the most accurate way of looking at the size, shape and location of places on the Earth. It is the most accurate three - dimensional representation of the earth. Globe shows the continents and oceans accurately.

But it has some drawbacks. Like:-

- ¶1. Only a part of the earth can be seen on a globe, at one glance.
- ¶2. All details can not be marked on a globe.
- ¶3. A globe is difficult to carry around.

To avoid these problems, we normally use maps instead of a globe.






What is a map?

A map is a representation or a drawing of the earth's surface or a part of it drawn on a flat surface according to a scale.

What is a sketch?

Sketch or a plan is a rough map with outlines drawn without a scale.



Differences between a Map and a Sketch

Map	Sketch
It has a scale	It has no scale
It is a carefully drawn area or a place	It is a roughly drawn area or a place
It requires the use of a special instrument	It requires no use of a special instrument



