What is a home?

- The house we live in with our family is our home.
- A house keeps us safe from the heat of the Sun and from the rain.
- We keep warm in our house when it is cold outside.
- Our house also keeps us safe from wild animals and from the Sun, the rain and the cold.

Different types of houses:

- There are different kinds of houses.
- Some houses are made of bricks and cement.
- Such houses are strong and safe.



- Some houses are made of mud and straw or dry grass.
- Such houses are called huts.
- Mud houses keep us cool but they are not very strong.



- Some houses are big and some are small.
- Sometimes a large building has many homes in it.
- These are called flats.



Rooms in a house:

- Some houses have many rooms.
- We do different things in different rooms.
- We sit and talk to our friends or watch TV in the drawing room or living room.



- We cook in the kitchen.



- We eat our meals in the dining room.



- We sleep in the bedroom.




- We have a bath in the bathroom.
