I say stop right away.


Yellow light, yellow light

- ❖ We must follow these rules at home and outside.




- ❖ We can be safe and avoid getting hurt by being careful.

★ At home


1. Do not play with fire.

★ Outside home


1. We must cross the road at zebra crossing.




2. Before you cross the road, look right, then left and then right again.

4. Do not lean out from the window of moving vehicles.



5. We must not get into or get down from a moving bus.
