Nouns are the naming words, name of persons, places, animals and things.

Examples:




Mother

Everything we see around us, has a name. So, nouns are also called as naming words.

TWO TYPES OF NOUNS

Proper Noun



I am a
special
name

... for a person, place, or thing.

Common Noun



I am a
common
name

Proper Noun- Proper Noun refers to a particular name of a person, place, animal and thing.

Note : Proper noun always begins with a capital letter.
