Nouns: Singular and Plural



Singular & Plural Nouns

A **Singular Noun** names one person, place, thing or idea.

Examples: fly, house, box, dream



A **Plural Noun** names 2 or more people, places, things, or ideas. Plural nouns have many spelling rules.



RECAPITULATE : (REGULAR PLURALS)

Most noun add **s** to form plural

Nouns that end with **sh, ch, o, x, z** or **s** add **es**

Nouns end with consonant + **y**,
change **y** to **i** and add **es**

Nouns that end with **f or fe**, change **f or fe** to **ves**



IRREGULAR PLURALS



Some nouns do not follow any of the above rules while changing to their plural forms. Such plural nouns are called **irregular plurals**.

EXAMPLES OF IRREGULAR PLURALS

Some nouns have different plurals.




