
The parts of a paragraph

Topic Sentence: It states the main idea of a paragraph.

Supporting Sentences: They Support the topic sentence. They explain the main idea. They give details relating to the main idea.

Closing Sentence: It restates or sums up the main idea.

Imagine a paragraph as a hamburger. The top bun is the topic sentence. The bottom bun is the closing sentence and the ingredients between the two buns are the supporting sentences.
