Deserts:-


- Deserts are large extremely dry areas of land.
- There is very little rainfall and few plants grow in deserts. Desert soil having very extreme temperature.
- In summer the days are very hot and nights are cool in winter days are cool and nights are very cold.



- A landmass which projects into the sea and is surrounded by water on three sides is called Peninsula.
- The tip of the peninsula is called Cape.




Example:- The Southern part of India is Peninsula and the Southern tip of Indian Peninsula is called Cape Comorin.



The Arabian Peninsula is the largest peninsula in the world.



A bay is a water body running into land and surrounded on three sides by land.
Ex- The Bay of Bengal along with the Eastern Coast of India.



An Island is a land mass surrounded on by all sides water.

Example-

- **Srilanka is an Island.**
- **Andaman and Nicobar Islands in the Bay of Bengal are the group of Islands.**
- **Australia is the largest Island in the world.**

Ans. Some Mountains are formed when two large landmasses push each other. They are called fold Mountains.
