## What is a Preposition?

**A Preposition is a word which is placed before a noun or a pronoun to show the relation in which the person or thing denoted by the Noun to something else.**

**For ex:**

- a) The book is **on** the table.
- b) The sky is **above** us.
- c) The pen is **in** the ink-pot.
- d) He came **with** us.

## Preposition of Time

**It tells us about the time of an action.**

**For ex:**

- 1) **In** the summer
- 2) **On** 25<sup>th</sup> January
- 3) **At** sunrise
- 4) **At** the moment



## Preposition of Place

It tells us about the location of a noun or pronoun.

For ex:

- 1) **At** the corner
- 2) **At** the bus stop
- 3) **On** the wall
- 4) **In** India

## Preposition of Movement/Direction

It tells us about the movement or direction of a noun or pronoun.

For ex:

- 1) **At** home
- 2) **Into** the river
- 3) I am going **to** Jaipur.
