Ans: Coal is used as a fuel:

Ans: Conglomerate is formed from pebbles and gravel cemented together by minerals and sand and carried by water.

It is used as an ornamental rock and for polishing ornaments.

3. How are the wings of a butterfly different from that of a bird?

Ans: a. The wings of a butterfly have no feathers or bones or strong muscles whereas the wings of a bird have feathers, bones and muscles.

b. The wings of a butterfly are made of tiny coloured scales whereas in case of a bird that is no such coloured scales.

c. Butterflies move with the help of their chest muscles whereas a bird moves with the help of its flight muscles.

4. What special features a herbivore has for eating their food?

Ans: Herbivores have sharp front teeth for biting and strong broad teeth for chewing their food.
