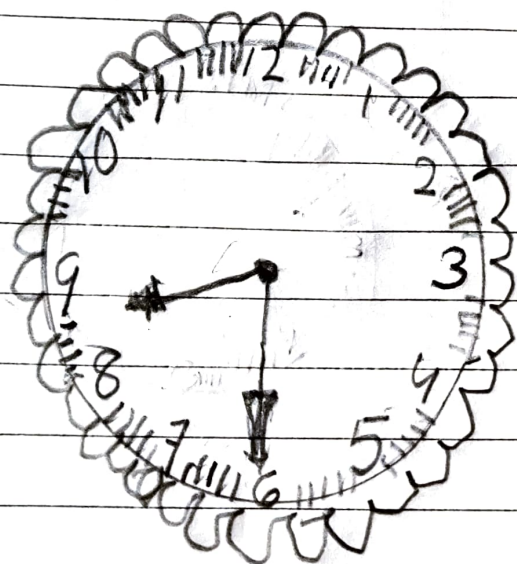


A 1 I go to school at 7 am in the morning
 2 I do my homework at 7 pm

B1 midday / noon 4 p.m.

10 am 2 p.m.

Half past 8

B1 9 pm $9 + 12 = 21:00$

2 6 pm $6 + 12 = 18:00$

C1 $18:00$ $18-12=6 \text{ p.m.}$

2 $21:00$ $21-12=9 \text{ p.m.}$

III A1 Convert 18 days into hours

Since 1 day = 24 Hours So, 18 days =

$$24 \times 18 \text{ days} = 432 \text{ Hours.}$$

2 Convert 11 days and 20 Hours

Since 1 day = 24 Hours So, 11 days =

$$11 \times 24 \text{ Hours} = 264 \text{ Hours Thus, 11 days}$$

$$\text{and 20 Hours} = 264 + 20 \text{ Hours} = 284 \text{ Hours.}$$

B Since 1 Hour = 60 min So, 8 Hours =

$$60 \times 8 \text{ Hours} = 480 \text{ min}$$

2 Since 1 Hours = 60 minutes So, 20 Hours
 $= 60 \times 20 \text{ Hours} = 1200 \text{ min}$ Thus, 20 Hours
 and 30 min $= 1200 + 30 \text{ min} = 1230 \text{ min}$

3 Since 1 Hours = 60 min So 16 Hours =
 $60 \times 16 \text{ Hours} = 960 \text{ min}$ Thus 16 Hours
 and 10 min $= 960 + 10 \text{ min} = 970 \text{ min}$
