Usage of Direct Pronoun.(He)

Example:

Piano is being played by him.

A goal is scored by Cristiano.

Usage of Indirect Pronoun.(Him)

Types of Sentences:

- ***Declarative Sentences: They are usually statements which tell us about something or give us information.***

They end with a full stop.(.)

Example: (a) Sun is the ultimate source of energy.

(b) Ravi will not be playing the match.

- **Interrogative Sentences:** They are usually questions which ask us something. They want information and they end with a question mark.(?)

*Example: (a) Where is she going right now?
(b) Is this the correct answer of that question ?*

- **Imperative Sentences:** They are usually commands which order us to do something. They either end with a full stop(.) or with an exclamation mark(!).

*Example: (a) Switch on the A.C.
(b) Get out of my room!*

- **Exclamatory Sentences:** They are usually an expression of strong emotion and tell us about the feeling of the person. They end with exclamation mark(!).

Example: (a) Such a lovely weather!

(b) What an expensive car!
