5) In which magazine did Gandhiji discuss his ideas about constitution and its working.


Gandhiji discussed his ideas about constitution and its working in young India magazine in 1931.

7) What is Preamble. Explain any 5 major ideals enshrined in the preamble to the Indian constitution?

The constitution begins with a short statement of its basic values which is called as the constitution.



The 5 major ideals of constitution are :-

- Sovereign → Sovereign means that people have supreme right to make decisions on internal as well as external matters. No external power can dictate the government of India.
- Socialist → The term socialist means that wealth is generated socially and should be shared equally by society. Government should also regulate ownership of land and industry to reduce - socio economic activities.

- Secular :- India is a secular country because citizens have complete freedom to follow any religion and there is no state/ official religion. Government treats all religious beliefs and practices with equal respect.
- Democratic :- A form of government where people enjoy equal political rights, elect their rulers, hold them accountable is known as democratic government. The government is running according to some basic rules.
- Republic :- According to constitution India is a republic country because the head of the state i.e. president is an elected one, not a hereditary one. The President is also selected after every 5 years.
